

Supply List

Sneaker Kit- <https://www.bucklebeebags.com/bucklebee-shop/happy-feet-quilted-sneaker-kit>

½ yard of By Annie or Bosal foam interlining (book recommends fusible but I prefer the sew in)

½ yard of mid weight fusible interfacing such as SF101

Fabric- choose one of the listed options

- Single fabric option (all shoe components from single fabric)
 - ½ yard of quilting weight
 - Fat quarter of quilting weight for binding
- Two fabric option
 - Fat quarter of quilting weight for upper
 - Fat quarter of quilting weight for lining
 - ¼ yard of quilting weight for tongue & binding
- Three fabric option
 - Fat quarter of quilting cotton for upper
 - 10" square of quilting cotton for tongue
 - Fat quarter for of quilting cotton for lining
 - Fat quarter of quilting weight for binding

7 yards of heavy waxed leatherworking cord (also known as artificial sinew)

Sharp awl or stiletto

Size 4 saddlers needle

⅜" two part eyelets (interior diameter of eyelet should be 3/16") I have a setting tool for class

- 32 for hightops

A hard thimble

Coordinating sewing thread- I prefer poly for the construction

One pair of shoe laces

- 60" for high tops
- 45" for for classic or ultra low

Sharp sewing scissors

Fabric/sewing clips

Sewing machine

Basic sewing supplies

Heat erasable marker or chalk

Fray check

Permanent flexible clear shoe making glue or shoe cement such as Angelus

Sneaker pattern- please print your size at the correct scale and cut it out

Pre-Class Instructions

Fuse the woven interfacing to your exterior fabric. Sandwich your exterior and lining fabric with the foam between and quilt as desired. At the beginning of class we will start with cutting out pieces and beginning construction of the shoes. Please email me if you have any questions
